

**Route 3
Turn Lane Extension Project
at Route 624 (Flat Iron Road)
Westmoreland County
Notice of Willingness**

Find out about the proposed project to extend the existing right turn lane on Route 3 at Route 624 (Flat Iron Road) in Westmoreland County. The project is located on Route 3 just east of Route 624 (Longwood Road). The project will provide additional storage for drivers making a right turn from Route 3 eastbound onto Route 624 (Flat Iron Road) and will include the construction of a stormwater management basin at the southwest corner of the intersection.

This turn lane extension project will compliment the approved Route 3 passing lanes project located between Potomac Mills and Flat Iron in Westmoreland County. The passing lane project is expected to begin later this year.

Review the project information and the environmental document, in the form of a Programmatic Categorical Exclusion at VDOT's Fredericksburg District Office, 87 Deacon Road, Fredericksburg, VA 22405, 540-899-4288 or TDD/TTY 711. If your concerns cannot be satisfied, VDOT is willing to hold a public hearing. You may request that a public hearing be held by sending a written request to Mr. Khalil Minhas, Project Manager, Virginia Department of Transportation, 87 Deacon Road, Fredericksburg, VA 22405 on or prior to **February 11, 2020**. If a request for a public hearing is received, notice of date, time, and place of the hearing will be posted.

In compliance with the National Historic Preservation Act, Section 106 and 36 CFR Part 800, information concerning the potential effects of the proposed improvements on properties listed in or eligible for listing in the National Register of Historic Places are included in the National Environmental Policy Act documentation.
