PIPE REPLACEMENTS BEGIN APRIL 14 ON ROUTE 55 *Expect daytime flagging operations between Linden and Markham*

CULPEPER — Crews will begin replacing multiple pipes on Route 55 (John Marshall Highway) between Linden and Markham in Fauquier County.

Starting April 14 and continuing weekdays from 8 a.m. to 6 p.m., Route 55 will be reduced to one lane controlled by flagging between Route 688 (Leeds Manor Road) and the Warren County line.

Motorists should use caution approaching the work zone and pay attention to flagger directions.
