**ROUTE 633 SAFETY IMPROVEMENTS PROJECT TO BEGIN IN  
GREENSVILLE COUNTY**  
*Construction starting as early as April 11*

**GREENSVILLE COUNTY**– A Virginia Department of Transportation (VDOT) project to improve safety on a section of Route 633 (Independence Church Road) near its intersection with Route 627 (Brink Road) in Greensville County is scheduled to begin construction as early as April 11.

Improvements to the 0.539 miles of roadway near the Route 627 intersection include increasing sight distance, tree clearing, rock excavation, grading and improvements to the existing asphalt pavement to extend its service life.

Throughout the duration of the project, motorists can expect daytime, single-lane closures on Route 633 in this area with flagging operations in place in both directions. Two-way traffic be maintained at all times and access will be maintained to all existing property entrances within this corridor.

Motorists will be advised of additional closures and detour information that may occur during the project. Construction is estimated to be complete this summer. All construction work is dependent upon weather conditions.

Jireh Construction Co. was awarded the \$381,184.00 construction contract for this project.
