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NEW TEMPORARY TRAFFIC SHIFTS SCHEDULED FOR ROUTE 460 BRIDGE REHABILITATION PROJECT

*New traffic patterns on Route 460 over Blackwater River beginning
as early as Aug. 18*

ISLE OF WIGHT COUNTY — Starting as early as Aug. 18, contractor crews with the Virginia Department of Transportation (VDOT) will move onto the next phase of rehabilitating the Route 460 (Windsor Boulevard/General Mahone Boulevard) bridge over Blackwater River in Isle of Wight County.

As early as Aug. 18, eastbound traffic will be shifted to the outside eastbound lane on the newly rehabilitated portion of the bridge, and westbound traffic will continue within the outside westbound lane on Route 460 between Zuni Circle and Tucker Swamp Road (Route 635). These lanes will continue to provide a single lane of traffic in both directions.

Motorists must use caution as workers and equipment will be entering and exiting the work zone within the inside lanes from both directions during this time.

As early as Aug. 25, westbound traffic will be shifted to the eastbound inside lane on the newly rehabilitated portion of the bridge, and eastbound traffic will continue within the outside eastbound lane on Route 460 between Zuni Circle and Tucker Swamp Road (Route 635). These lanes will continue to provide a single lane of traffic in both directions on Route 460, as these shifts allow for rehabilitation of the westbound side of the bridge.

These traffic patterns are estimated to be in place through fall 2022, when a new traffic pattern will take place prior to completion of the project. A single, reduced-width lane of traffic will be maintained in each direction on Route 460 until project completion.

The temporary road configuration includes the use of barriers and markers to delineate lanes. Wide loads exceeding 10 feet 6 inches are advised to use alternate routes.

The suggested alternate route for restricted vehicles is as follows:

To Route 460 west:

- Turn left on Route 258;
- Take Route 58 Business to Route 35;
- Turn right on Route 616; and
- Turn left on Route 460.

To Route 460 east:

- Turn right Route 616;
- Turn left on Route 35;
- Follow Route 58 to Route 258; and

- Turn right on Route 460.

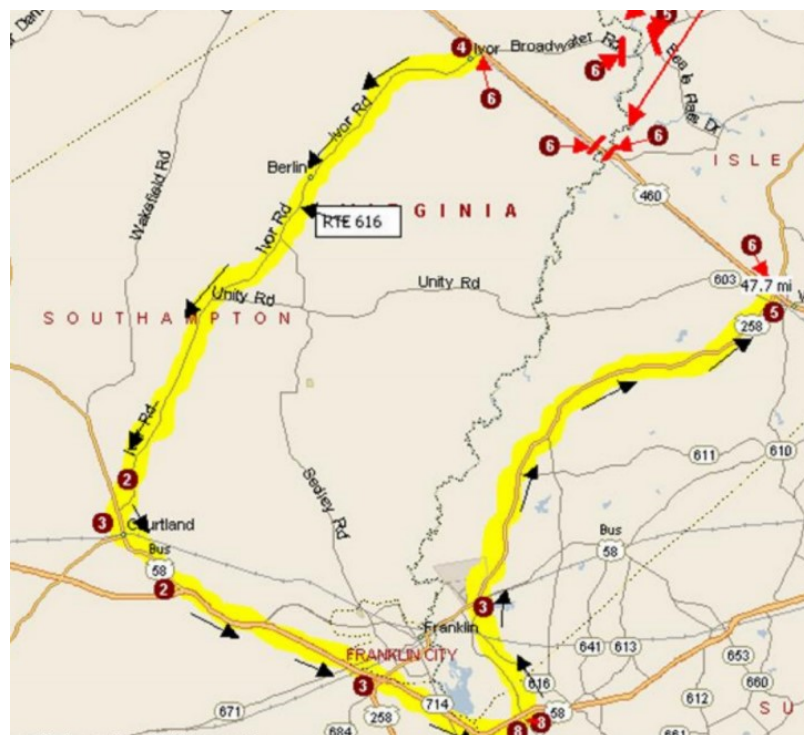
VDOT and the contractor will work to minimize impacts and mitigate traffic issues as much as possible throughout the project duration. During construction, access will also be maintained for local businesses and residences. Motorists will be advised of any major additional lane closures, width restrictions, or traffic shifts that may occur during the project. This work is dependent upon weather conditions; therefore, the schedule and duration of the work are subject to change.
