

INTERMITTENT STOPPAGES SCHEDULED FOR DOMINION ENERGY WORK THIS WEEKEND

Motorists are alerted to potential traffic delays on Interstate 64 near Fort Eustis Boulevard (exit 250) this weekend for safety as Dominion Energy rebuilds a high-voltage transmission line.

The work will require intermittent stoppages both east and westbound in the vicinity of Exit 250 (Ft. Eustis Boulevard) between the hours of 6:30 a.m. and 11 a.m. on Saturday (Dec. 4) with a back-up date of Sunday (Dec. 5). The traffic interruptions could last up to 15 minutes with a 15-minute interval between each stop.

Dominion Energy is rebuilding important infrastructure to plan for future reliability. That involves pulling a transmission line across all travel lanes. The work has been coordinated with the Virginia Department of Transportation.

Motorists are encouraged to plan ahead if traveling I-64 near Ft. Eustis this weekend.
