ROUTE 610 BRIDGE REPLACEMENT PROJECT COMPLETED AHEAD OF SCHEDULE IN SUSSEX COUNTY

Harrell Road open to traffic as of Sept. 30

SUSSEX COUNTY– As of Sept. 30, Route 610 (Harrell Road) in Sussex County is open to traffic following the completion of a full superstructure replacement at the bridge over South Fork Poplar Swamp between Route 631 (Henry Road) and Route 609 (Gray Road).

Virginia Department of Transportation (VDOT) crews installed new steel beams, a new wooden deck, and a new up-to-date guardrail.

Construction began earlier this month and was originally scheduled to be completed in October 2022.
