JAMESTOWN-SCOTLAND FERRY SERVICE RESUMES

SURRY COUNTY – As of Saturday, Dec. 24 at 10:30 a.m., operations have resumed at the Jamestown-Scotland Ferry after service was suspended on Friday, Dec. 23 at noon due to high winds associated with the winter storm.
