**PORTION OF ROUTE 690 TO TEMPORARILY CLOSE OVER LAKE
PRINCE/ENNIS POND AS BRIDGE REPLACEMENT PROJECT BEGINS**

Closure with signed detour in place to begin as early as Dec. 13

ISLE OF WIGHT COUNTY – A Virginia Department of Transportation (VDOT) project to replace the Route 690 (Ennis Mill Road) bridge over Lake Prince/Ennis Pond began on Dec. 8 with crews placing construction signage. Starting as early as Dec. 13, a portion of Route 690 (Ennis Mill Road) will be closed to through traffic between Route 460 (Windsor Boulevard/Pruden Boulevard) and Route 606 (Five Forks Road). The road will remain closed to through traffic until as early as fall 2022.

This closure will allow crews to safely perform bridge replacement work. The existing bridge on Route 690 will be replaced with a pre-stressed concrete box beam bridge with permanent sheet pile walls. Additionally, the bridge will be widened to 23-feet and lengthened to 59-feet, along with roadway widening to match the bridge approaches in both directions. The existing bridge will be demolished in a single phase of demolition with signed detours re-routing traffic to utilize Route 611 (Gardner Lane) to access Route 460 (Windsor Boulevard/Pruden Boulevard) and Route 606 (Five Forks Road).

Residents on Route 690 (Ennis Mill Road) will maintain access to their properties.

Bryant Structures, Inc. was awarded the \$1.7 million construction contract and will begin work on the project in late 2021. The bridge replacement project is estimated to be complete in fall 2022. All construction work is dependent upon weather conditions.
