GOVERNOR HARRISON PARKWAY (ROUTE 58) EAST CLOSED FOR EMERGENCY PIPE REPAIRS IN BRUNSWICK

Motorists should use posted detour until work is complete

BRUNSWICK – The Virginia Department of Transportation (VDOT) has closed all eastbound lanes of Governor Harrison Parkway (Route 58) near Evans Creek Road (Route 623) in Brunswick County for emergency pipe repair work. Weather permitting, work is expected to be complete by the morning of Tuesday, May 5.

During work, drivers should follow the posted detour route:

- From Governor Harrison Pkwy. (Rt. 58) east, take the ramp to I-85 north to Exit 27 (Christanna Hwy., Rt. 46). Turn right and continue on Rt. 46 back to Rt. 58.
