EXPECT NIGHTLY LANE CLOSURES ON I-195 IN RICHMOND

Crews will be installing safety shielding as part of ongoing bridge rehabilitation project

RICHMOND – Beginning Monday, January 13, the Virginia Department of Transportation (VDOT) will have nightly double lane closures in place on I-195 north and south at Powhite Parkway (Route 76) to allow crews to install safety shielding beneath the bridge. Closures will be in place from 8 p.m.-6 a.m. nightly through Friday morning, January 17. Drivers should use extra caution and follow guiding signage when the work zone is in place.

The safety shielding will allow workers to rehabilitate the bridge safely from below while maintaining all lanes of traffic on I-195. The shielding will also protect the surfaces beneath the bridge.

The work is part of an ongoing [bridge rehabilitation project](#) for the I-195 south bridge over Powhite Parkway and CSX rail, slated to be complete in spring 2021. The ramp from Cary Street/Cameron Avenue to I-195 south remains closed with a detour in place to accommodate this work.
