OAK GROVE ROAD (ROUTE 606) TO CLOSE FOR CROSS PIPE INSTALLATION IN DINWIDDIE

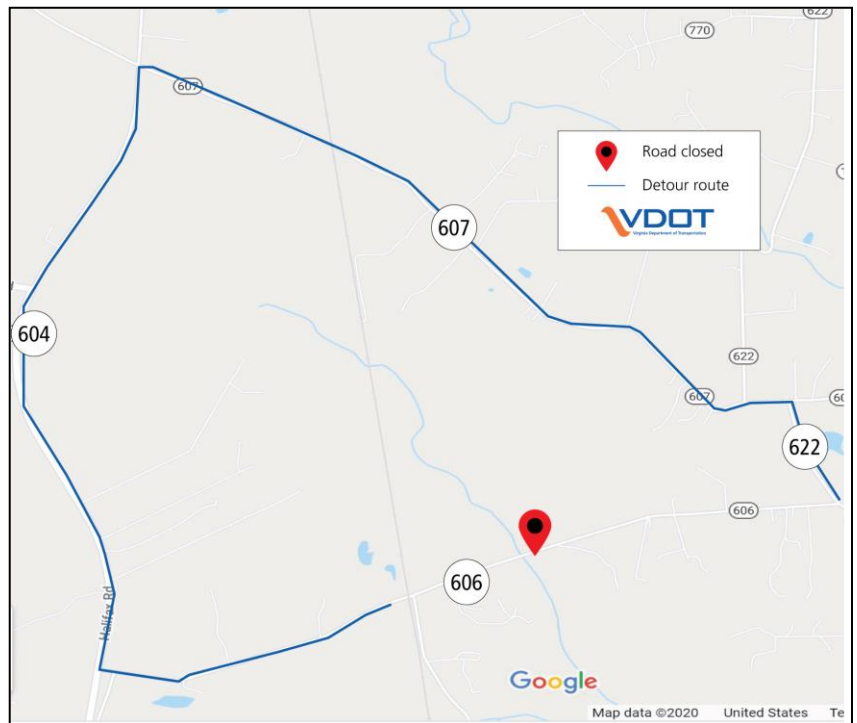
Drivers should follow posted detour route

DINWIDDIE – Weather permitting, the Virginia Department of Transportation (VDOT) will close Oak Grove Road (Route 606) between Halifax Road (Route 604) and Providence Road (Route 622) in Dinwiddie County for approximately 15 days. The closure starts on Monday, July 13.

During the road closure, the following detour route will be in place:

From Oak Grove Road, take Halifax Road (Route 604) to Butler Branch Road (Route 607), to Providence Road (Route 622), to Reams Road, which becomes Oak Grove Road again in Prince George County.

The closure is for a cross pipe installation project.
