ROUTE 250 CLOSED IN GOOCHLAND CO. DUE TO PIPE FAILURE

Road closed to through traffic, follow detour

CULPEPER — Motorists should expect an extended closure of Route 250 (Broad Street Road) in Goochland County between Route 604 (Whitesel Road) and Route 605 (Shannon Hill Road) due to a pipe failure.

Traffic is being detoured via Route 604 to Route 653 (Three Chopt Road) to Route 605 which carries traffic back to Route 250.

Before the new pipe can be set in place, the damaged pipe must be dug out and removed. That will require excavating the soil above and around the pipe which sits several feet below the road. After removing the pipe, crews will install the new pipe, backfill and repave the road.

The road will likely remain closed until Dec. 22.
