BRIDGE OVER I-95 IN CHESTERFIELD HAS NEW WEIGHT RESTRICTIONS

Heavy trucks use Route 10 as an alternate route

CHESTERFIELD, Va. – New weight restrictions were instituted on the Old Bermuda Hundred Road (Route 618) bridge over I-95 in Chesterfield County by the Virginia Department of Transportation (VDOT). Heavy trucks weighing 13 tons or more should use Route 10/West Hundred Road as an alternate route.

The Old Bermuda Hundred Road bridge is located in Chester between the Route 10 Chester/Hopewell exits and the Woods Edge Road/Ruffin Mill Road exits (around mile marker 60). During an inspection, VDOT found one of the interior bridge structures was damaged by an over-height vehicle, which is the reason for the new weight restrictions. Repairs to the bridge are estimated to be complete by late winter/early spring 2023.
