SECTION OF GREENWOOD ROAD (ROUTE 625) CLOSED DUE TO PIPE FAILURE IN HANOVER

Drivers should use posted detour route until further notice

HANOVER, Va. – The Virginia Department of Transportation (VDOT) has closed a section of Greenwood Road (Route 625) between Ashland Road (Route 623) and Winns Church Road (Route 660) due to an emergency pipe failure. The closure will be in place until further notice.

During this closure, drivers should follow the posted detour route:

- **Eastbound Greenwood Rd. (Rt. 625)** – Take Winns Church Rd. (Rt. 660) west to Mountain Rd. (Rt. 33) north to Ashland Rd. (Rt. 623) north back to Greenwood Rd.
- **Westbound Greenwood Rd. (Rt. 625)** – Take Ashland Rd. (Rt. 623) south to Mountain Rd. (Rt. 33) south to Winns Church Rd. (Rt. 660) east back to Greenwood Rd.
