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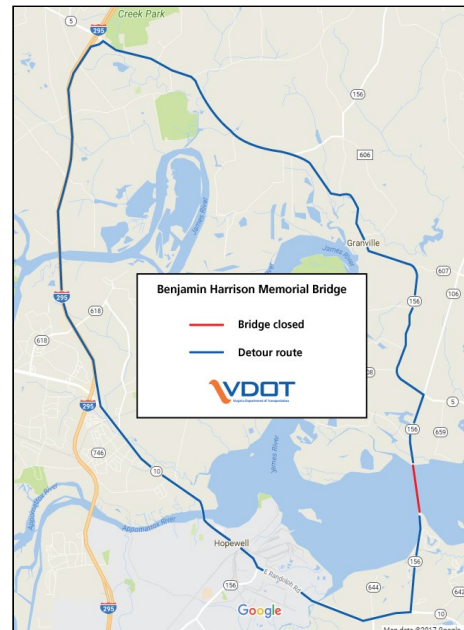
PREPARE FOR CLOSURES ON BENJAMIN HARRISON BRIDGE IN CHARLES CITY, PRINCE GEORGE STARTING DECEMBER 9

Drivers should use posted detour

CHARLES CITY/PRINCE GEORGE – Motorists should prepare for full closures of the Benjamin Harrison Bridge on Jordan Point Road (Route 156)/Roxbury Road (Route 106) in Charles City and Prince George starting the evening of Friday, December 9.

Closures are listed as follows:

- A full closure will be in effect from 7 p.m. Friday, December 9 to approximately 5 a.m. Monday, December 12.
- Nightly full closures will be in effect from 7 p.m. to approximately 5 a.m. Monday, December 12 – Thursday, Dec. 15. Drivers will be able to use the bridge from approximately 5 a.m. to 7 p.m. on these dates.



Weather permitting, work is expected to be complete and all full closures lifted at 5 a.m. Friday, December 16.

The following detour will be in place during periods of full closure:

Northbound Route 156/106 - Take Jordan Point Road (Route 156) south to Route 10 west to I-295 north to Route 5 (Exit 22A) east back to Route 156/106.

Southbound Route 156/106 - Take Roxbury Road (Route 106) north to Route 5 west to I-295 south to Route 10 (Exit 15A) east back to Route 156/106.

Through travelers can use Interstates 295 and 64 or the Jamestown-Scotland Ferry as alternate routes to the Hampton Roads area.
