SLOW ROLLS TO IMPACT TRAFFIC ON I-95 IN RICHMOND

Slow rolls will occur overnight over the next several months

RICHMOND, Va. – The Virginia Department of Transportation (VDOT) will implement overnight slow rolls on I-95 north and south in Richmond to facilitate beam removal and installation as part of an ongoing [bridge rehabilitation project](#).

The slow rolls will take place between Maury Street (mile marker 73) and Arthur Ashe Boulevard (mile marker 78) between 10 p.m. and 6 a.m. beginning Wednesday, July 27 and may occur occasionally over the next several months. Drivers should expect delays in 15-minute intervals with 45 minutes in between to allow normal traffic flow.

Signs will be posted in advance of the work locations notifying traffic of ongoing slow roll operations.
