PAVING OPERATIONS ON ROUTE 761 IN CLARKE COUNTY SEPTEMBER 24-26

STAUNTON – Motorists should expect delays on part of Route 761 (Old Charlestown Road) in Clarke County from 7 a.m. to 7 p.m. Friday through Sunday, September 24-26. Flagging crews will control traffic due to paving operations between Route 659 (Longmarsh Road) and the Frederick County line.

Digital message signs will alert drivers to the Route 761 work zone. All work is weather permitting.
