1. Rt. 29 widening, Polo Grounds Rd. to Town Center Dr.
 - add one lane in each direction
2. Best Buy ramp
 - construct merge lane and 2nd ramp lane
3. Hillsdale Dr. Extension, Hydraulic Rd. to Greenbrier Dr.
 - construct one lane in each direction with turning lanes

The Rt. 29 Solution Projects (continued)

4. Hillsdale South, Holiday Dr. to Hydraulic Rd.

- construct new 2-lane roadway

5. Berkmar Dr. Extension, Hilton Heights Rd. to Town Center Dr.

- construct new roadway

6. Rio Rd. Grade Separated Intersection

- reconstruction with added capacity

Project Delivery Approach, Objectives, Schedule

- Design-Bid-Build: Best Buy Ramp, Hillsdale Extension (Hillsdale Extension may move to DB package)
- On-Call services: Adaptive Signal Timing
- Design-Build: Rt. 29 widening, Hillsdale South, Berkmar, Rio Grade Separated Intersection

Project Delivery Objectives

- Complete construction of Best Buy Ramp no later than July 31, 2016
- Complete adaptive signal timing no later than July 31, 2016
- Establish a firm no-excuses deadline to complete construction of all design-build projects no later than October 31, 2017.
- Complete Rio Grade Separated Intersection between Final Exercises and 1st UVA football game with incentives to complete in 2016.

Design-Build Project Delivery Schedule

- Jul 24: Request for Qualifications advertised (RFQ)
- Aug 28: Qualification packages due from contractors
- Sep 25: Contractor teams shortlisted
- Oct 2: Request for Technical and Price Proposals issued (RFP)
- Dec 4: Technical and price proposals due from contractors
- Jan 16: Notice of Intent to award a contract
- Feb 18: CTB approval of award

Field Activities Beginning in July

Surveys and investigations for engineering, including

- ground elevations
