This \$6 million project replaces and widens the Glebe Road bridge over Arlington Boulevard (Route 50). Overnight traffic impacts will begin in early June, and the entire project is expected to be complete in late summer 2012.

Additional improvements and features include:

- A northbound left-turn lane to Route 50
- A 17-foot shared-use path on one side and 11-foot sidewalk on the other
- Improved sight distance for right turns from Route 50 to Glebe Road
- New signals
- Decorative wrought-iron picket fencing, gateway pillars and LED lighting
