NEW TRAFFIC PATTERNS ON ROUTE 17 AT ROUTE 258 INTERSECTION

New merge lane from Route 17 south to Route 258 west is open

ISLE OF WIGHT COUNTY – Starting as early as Jan. 4, motorists traveling the Route 17 (Carrollton Boulevard) to Route 258 (Brewers Neck Boulevard) intersection should anticipate new traffic patterns as progress continues on the intersection improvements project in Isle of Wight County.

As the project moves forward, motorists will follow the below new patterns:

- From Route 17 south to Route 258 west:
 - Pavement markings and signage directing motorists to merge with traffic turning left from Route 17 north onto Route 258 west
- From Route 17 north to Route 258 west:
 - Two left turn lanes with pavement markings
- From Route 258 east to Route 17 north:
 - Two left turn lanes with pavement markings

The through lane from Route 258 east to the private development will remain blocked as the developer continues work.

All work as part of the Route 17 at Route 258 Capacity Improvement Project is weather-dependent and subject to change.
