

LABOR DAY 2021

VDOT will lift most lane closures for holiday travel from noon Friday, Sept. 3, until noon Tuesday, Sept. 7. However, motorists may encounter semi-permanent work zones or travel delays in the following locations:

Amelia County

Route 360/Patrick Henry Highway – Replacing bridge over Route 360 Business. Westbound traffic shifted to eastbound lanes to allow construction of the westbound bridge.

Bedford County

Route 460 – Realignment of eastbound lanes near Montvale. Eastbound and westbound lanes reduced to one lane. Speed limit reduced to 45 mph. Traffic shift in place with eastbound lanes using westbound lane with barrier in between. Wilkerson Mill Road access is closed at Route 460 with detour in place.

Botetourt County

Route 220 – Making safety improvements between Eagle Rock and Iron Gate. Traffic pattern shift in place at the intersection with South Chatham. Lane and shoulder closures with flaggers possible. Width restriction of 11 feet. Speed limit reduced to 35 mph or 45 mph in work zones.

Campbell County

U.S. 29 – Rehabilitating northbound bridge and approaches over Norfolk-Southern Rail near airport. Lane closures possible.

Caroline County

Route 207 - Replacing a southbound bridge over the Mattaponi River. Traffic is reduced to a single lane in each direction, with all traffic traveling over the river in the northbound lanes.

City of Chesapeake

I-64 Southside Widening & High Rise Bridge Expansion Project – Widening interstate between I-264/Bowers Hill and Battlefield Boulevard. Speed limit reduced to 55 mph in both directions.

- Libertyville Road will remain closed in both directions at Bainbridge Boulevard for the new High Rise Bridge construction.
- Military Highway lane capacity has been reduced to one lane in each direction at the I-64 interchange for bridge construction.

Chesterfield County

Route 10/W. Hundred Road – Widening road from Bermuda Triangle Road to Rivers Bend Boulevard in both directions. Speed limit in work zone reduced to 45 mph.

Route 10/I-95 Interchange – Improving interchange. Ramp from W. Hundred Road (Route 10) west to I-95 north restricted to a width of 12 feet. I-95 north shoulder is closed between mile markers 60.8 and 62.

Fauquier County

Route 17 – Rehabilitating bridge over the railroad near Bealeton. Southbound traffic restricted to one lane with a width restriction of 12 feet.

Gloucester/Middlesex

Route 17 - Replacing a southbound bridge over Dragon Run. Southbound traffic is reduced to a single lane.

Halifax County

U.S. 501 – Constructing passing lane near Route 610. Route 610 connections closed. 35 mph speed limit. Lane closures and temporary detours possible.

Hanover County

Kings Dominion Boulevard (Route 30) - Bridge rehabilitation project over North Anna River. Westbound left lane closed through project limits.

Cold Harbor Road (Route 156) - Turn lane construction project at Catlin Road. Westbound lanes closed to through traffic. Detour signs and message boards in place.

James City County

Route 612 Longhill Road Widening Project – Widening Longhill Road from east of Williamsburg West Drive to Glenburnie Road. Speed limit reduced to 35 mph in both directions through work zone.

Lee County

Route 58 - Replacing bridge over the Powell River. Signals are controlling one-way traffic.

Lynchburg

U.S. 29/460 – Constructing bridge over Norfolk-Southern Railroad between Campbell Avenue and Concord Turnpike. Speed reduced to 45 mph on U.S. 29 North/U.S. 460 East.

Montgomery County

I-81 – Replacing northbound and southbound bridges over Route 8 at exit 114. Shoulders closed with median barriers in place from mile marker 113 to 114. Speed limit reduced to 60 mph in work zone. Closure of exit 114 ramps possible. A temporary traffic signal directs traffic on Route 8.

City of Newport News

Route 173 – Replacing bridge on Route 173 (Denbigh Boulevard) over I-64. Bridge traffic reduced to one lane in each direction. Access to Denbigh Boulevard from Richneck Road closed.

City of Norfolk/City of Hampton

HRBT Expansion Project (I-64 east and west from Settlers Landing Road to I-564) – Roadway widening. All travel lanes open. Concrete barriers in place along the shoulder throughout the work zone.

Page County

Route 211 – Replacing westbound bridge over Shenandoah River South Fork. Single-lane traffic in each direction using eastbound bridge. Work zone speed limit 45 miles an hour.

Pittsylvania County

U.S. 29 – Bridge reduced to one 15-foot lane northbound over Banister River.

Pulaski County/Montgomery County

I-81 – Replacing northbound bridge over the New River at the Pulaski/Montgomery County line. Lane and shoulder closures in place between mile markers 103 and 105. Speed limit reduced to 60 mph in work zone. Width restriction is 11 feet.

City of Richmond

4th Street - Two segments closed for roundabout construction at the I-95, Maury Street interchange. 4th Street is closed between Everett Street and Maury Street, and is also closed between Maury Street and the on ramp to I-95. Use alternate routes.

Roanoke City

Route 460 (Orange Avenue) – Intersection improvements underway. Traffic switch with lane closures in place to reconstruct median.

Roanoke County

I-81 – Widening lanes northbound and southbound between exits 141 to 143. Barrier walls in place.

Stafford County/City of Fredericksburg

Route 3 Business - Rehabilitating bridge over the Rappahannock River. Detour in place.

Stafford County/Spotsylvania County/City of Fredericksburg

Interstate 95 - Construction work zone for multiple Improve 95 projects between exits 148 (Quantico) and 126 (Spotsylvania). Shoulder closures in place along I-95 north and south at various locations.

Southampton County

Route 671 Bridge Replacement at the Nottoway River - Route 671 between Shady Brook Trail and Buckhorn Drive is closed with a signed detour in place.

York County

I-64 Widening Segment III Project – Widening interstate from Route 199/Humelsine Parkway (exit 242) to Route 199/Lightfoot (exit 234). Speed limit reduced to 55 mph in both directions through work zone.

- Consecutive, long-term full ramp closures on Route 143 (Merrimac Trail) north to I-64 west. Follow posted detour.
- Consecutive, long-term full ramp closure and diversion on the existing Route 199 west on-ramp to I-64 west in Lightfoot. Follow posted detour to temporary median crossover.
